- **TEAM ENTRY FEE: \$500**
 - Entry Fee Includes:

- **GOLF CARTS:**
 - Golf cart use is included in the team entry fee for teams that need one. Teams with access to their own golf cart are strongly encouraged to bring/use it. Teams needing SAGC to provide a golf cart must indicate so on the registration form. Because SAGC has a limited fleet of club-owned carts, advance notice is required so additional carts can be coordinated as necessary. Cart requests must be submitted by Monday, September 21, 2026 at 5:00PM MST. Requests or changes made after this deadline cannot be guaranteed.
- **REGISTRATION DATES:**
 - Entries Open: August 10th, 2026 @ 5PM MST
 - Entries Close: Monday, September 21, 2026 at 5PM MST, or when the 60-team field is full, whichever occurs first
 - Entries are accepted on a first-come, first-served basis. A team is officially registered only after Spreading Antlers Golf Club has received BOTH:
 - A fully completed 2026 Two Shot Golf Tournament Registration Form; and
 - The full \$500 team entry fee
 - A registration form without payment will not reserve a spot. Payment without a completed registration form will not reserve a spot. Registration priority is determined by the date and time both the completed registration form and full payment are received by SAGC. Mailed registrations are based on the date received by SAGC, not the postmark date. Once both items have been received and the team has been accepted into the tournament, SAGC will send an official registration confirmation to the team's designated Team Captain/Primary Contact.

- **WAITLIST:**

- If the 60-team field reaches capacity, additional complete registrations will be placed on a first-come, first-served waitlist based on the date and time both the completed registration form and full entry payment are received by SAGC. If a tournament spot becomes available, waitlisted teams will be contacted in order. A team placed on the waitlist is not considered officially entered in the tournament until SAGC confirms its acceptance into the field.

- **CANCELLATION & REFUND POLICY:**

- Once a team's registration has been officially confirmed, no refunds will be issued for any reason. The no-refund policy applies only after a team has been officially accepted and confirmed into the tournament field.

Format & Rules:

- **TEAM ELIGIBILITY:**

- Tournament format is two-player teams
- All participants must be 18 years of age or older as of September 21st, 2026
- Teams must consist of either two men or two women.
- Maximum field: 60 teams

- **GHIN & HANDICAP REQUIREMENTS:**

- A valid GHIN Handicap Index is required for all players. Each player must have a minimum of five 18-hole rounds recorded in GHIN during the 2026 season by the registration deadline. Nine-hole scores converted by GHIN into an 18-hole differential count toward this requirement.
- SAGC will pull each player's current GHIN Handicap Index following the registration deadline, approximately **September 22nd through 23rd, 2026**, for tournament handicap and quota calculations.
- Maximum Handicaps:
 - Men's: 20 | Women's: 28

- **10-STROKE PARTNER RULE:**

- Playing partners may have no more than a 10-stroke difference between their Course Handicaps for tournament purposes. If the difference between partners exceeds 10 strokes, the higher-handicap player's Course Handicap will be reduced to within 10 strokes of their partner before the player's tournament quota is established.

- **COURSE HANDICAP CALCULATION**

- SAGC will calculate each player's tournament Course Handicap using the USGA Course Handicap Calculator and the player's:
 - Current GHIN Handicap Index, Assigned SAGC Tee, Applicable Course Rating, Applicable Slope Rating, Applicable Course Par
- Each player's resulting Course Handicap will be rounded up to the nearest whole number for tournament purposes.
- The 10-stroke partner rule will then be applied, if necessary, before the team quota is calculated.

- **TEAM QUOTA CALCULATION**

- To establish the team quota, SAGC will:
 1. Determine Player A's Course Handicap.
 2. Determine Player B's tournament Course Handicap.
 3. Apply the 10-stroke partner rule, if necessary
 4. Add the two Course Handicaps together.
 5. Subtract the combined Course Handicap from SAGC'S course par of 70.
- Example:
 - Player A Course Handicap: 11
 - Player B Course Handicap: 12
 - Combined Course Handicap: 23
 - $70 - 23 = \text{Team Quota of } 47$
- Men's Team Quota: For men's teams, 100% of the calculated team quota will be used
- Women's Team Quota: For women's teams, 80% of the calculated team quota will be used. After the 80% adjustment is applied, the resulting quota will be rounded up to the nearest whole number.

- **STABLEFORD QUOTA SCORING**

- Each player earns Stableford points on every hole according to the following scoring system:
 - Double-Bogey or Worse: 0 Points
 - Bogey: 1 Point
 - Par: 2 Points
 - Birdie: 4 Points
 - Eagle: 8 Points
 - Double Eagle/Albatross: 10 Points
- A hole-in-one is scored according to its relationship to par. For example, a hole-in-one on a Par 3 is an Eagle (8 points), while a hole-in-one on a Par 4 is an Albatross (10 points).
- Each team's Stableford points for a hole are combined, and that total is written on the scorecard. The team's round score is determined by the number of points scored above or below its quota.
- **Players must pick up once they can no longer score bogey on a hole.**

- **TEE ASSIGNMENTS:**

- Men age 75+ → Gold / Gold Tees
- Men age 70-74 → Gold / White Tees
- Men 69 and Under → White / Blue Tees
- Women → Red / Red Tees

- **TOURNAMENT ROUND ROTATIONS:**

- Each team will play one AM shotgun and one PM shotgun during the tournament.
- Teams will be assigned one of the following rotations:
 - Saturday AM → Sunday PM
 - Saturday PM → Sunday AM
- Teams may indicate their preferred rotation on the registration form. SAGC will make every effort to accommodate rotation preferences; however, requested rotations are not guaranteed.

- **MULLIGANS:**

- Mulligans are available for \$20 per player and include two mulligans total. Each player may use one mulligan during Saturday's tournament round and one during Sunday's tournament round, and mulligans may be used on any shot, including putts. Mulligans cannot be carried over from one day to the next, and any unused mulligan for that day's round is forfeited. Once a player declares the use of a mulligan, the original shot is immediately out of play. The mulligan must be played from the location of the original shot, and the player must accept the result of the mulligan shot.

Registration Confirmation

A team's spot is not officially reserved or confirmed until Spreading Antlers Golf Club has received both the completed registration form and the full \$500 team entry fee. Once both have been received and the team has been accepted into the tournament field, SAGC will send an official confirmation to the designated Team Captain / Primary Contact.

Liability Waiver, Assumption of Risk, Golf Cart Responsibility, & Tournament Rules Acknowledgement

PLEASE READ CAREFULLY BEFORE SIGNING

By signing below, each player certifies that they are 18 years of age or older and voluntarily elects to participate in the 2026 Two Shot Golf Tournament and its related activities.

Assumption of Risk & Release of Liability

Each player understands and acknowledges that participation in golf and tournament-related activities involves inherent and other risks, including, but not limited to, being struck by golf balls or golf clubs; slips, trips, and falls; uneven or changing terrain; weather conditions; collisions with persons, objects, or golf carts; golf cart accidents or rollovers; equipment failure; and the actions of other participants, spectators, employees, volunteers, or third parties. Each player knowingly and voluntarily assumes the risks associated with participation in the 2026 Two Shot Golf Tournament, including tournament rounds, the optional Friday scramble, mini-games, practice activities, use of SAGC facilities and grounds, and operation or use of a golf cart. To the fullest extent permitted by Colorado law, each player releases and agrees to hold harmless Spreading Antlers Golf Club, its Board of Directors, officers, employees, agents, volunteers, sponsors, property owners or lessors, and owners or lenders of golf carts provided for tournament use from claims for personal injury, death, property damage, or other loss arising from participation in the tournament or related activities, including claims arising from ordinary negligence. This release does not apply to conduct or claims that cannot legally be waived.

Golf Cart Responsibility

Each player acknowledges that a golf cart provided or coordinated by SAGC for tournament use may be owned by Spreading Antlers Golf Club or privately owned and temporarily loaned for tournament use. Both members of the team jointly accept responsibility for the proper care, use, operation, and safeguarding of any golf cart assigned to their team. Players agree to operate the cart in a safe and responsible manner, comply with all SAGC golf cart and course rules and instructions, and refrain from operating a golf cart while impaired by alcohol, drugs, or any other condition that may affect safe operation. If an assigned golf cart is damaged, lost, or destroyed while in the team's possession or control as a result of misuse, negligence, reckless operation, collision, unauthorized use, or violation of SAGC or tournament rules, both team members agree to be financially responsible for the reasonable cost of necessary repairs or, if the cart cannot reasonably be repaired, its fair-market replacement value. Players will not be held responsible for normal wear and tear, documented pre-existing damage, or mechanical failure not caused by the team's use or operation of the cart. Any accident, damage, malfunction, or other issue involving an assigned golf cart must be reported to SAGC staff immediately.

Tournament Rules Acknowledgement

By signing below, each player acknowledges that they have read, understand, and agree to comply with all rules, requirements, and policies of the 2026 Two Shot Golf Tournament, including participant eligibility and age requirements, GHIN and handicap requirements, Course Handicap and team quota calculations, Stableford Quota scoring, tee assignments, the 10-stroke partner rule, mulligan rules, tournament round assignments and scheduling, golf cart policies, registration and payment requirements, the tournament's no-refund policy, and all reasonable instructions issued by SAGC staff and tournament officials during the event. Each player further understands that failure to comply with tournament or SAGC rules may result in penalties or disqualification as determined by tournament officials.
